



City of Aliso Viejo has lowest unemployment rate of all Orange County cities

According to data released by the Employment Development Department (EDD), the City of Aliso Viejo has the lowest unemployment rate of any other incorporated city in Orange County.

The data released in February 2010 ranks the labor force; employment and unemployment number and rate; and census ratios of counties throughout the state of California.

Aliso Viejo, a city of more than 45,000, has a 5.2 percent unemployment rate, according to the data. In comparison, surrounding cities such as Laguna Hills and Laguna Niguel are said to have unemployment rates of 8.2 percent and 7.6 percent, respectively.
